ADMISSION NOTIFICATION FOR THREE TEACHER TRAINING COURSES: TWO YEARS B.ED. COURSE (GENERAL), TWO YEARS M.ED. COURSE AND TWO YEARS B.ED.SPL.ED(LD) COURSE (UNDER PROCESS BY RCI, NEW DELHI FOR THE CURRENT SESSION), 2019-20.

- Both the B.Ed. and M.Ed. Programmes of HCTE are recognized by ERC, NCTE, Bhubaneswar, Vide Letter No. ERC/7-64.10.0/2006/442-447 dated 18th Feb. 2006 (the revised order no. ERC/NCTE/ ERCAPE00531/B.Ed.(Revised Order)/2015/31612, dated 9th May 2015) and Order no. F.No.ER-250.6.12/ERCAPP2737/M.ED./2018/56132, dated 23rd February 2018.
- B.Ed.Spl.Ed(LD) course in the area of Learning Disability is recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India(RCI), New Delhi, since the academic session 2016-17 and the proposal under process for the current academic session, 2019-20.
- The admission to all the courses will be purely **on the basis of merit**.
- Duration of the programmes for all the three courses is **two (02) years each**.
- Medium of Instruction & Examination is English.
- No age bar to apply for courses.
- Hostel Facility available for female students only
- Transport Facility is also available.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

1. For B.Ed. program the minimum eligibilities are:
 - Candidate with M.A./ M.Sc./ M.Com/ B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com./(B.E./B.Tech. with Specialization in Sc. & Mathematics having 55% marks) degree from Rajiv Gandhi University or any other recognized University with at least 50% marks in the qualifying degree examination under (10+2+3) pattern/ scheme is eligible for admission into B.Ed.(General) course.
 - SC, ST and OBC (NCL) candidates shall be given relaxation of 5% marks. NCL candidates should produce NCL certificate issued for the current year.
 - Candidates who are appearing in qualifying (Bachelor Degree) Examination can also apply. **However, such candidates will have to submit the proof of having passed the qualifying examination latest by 15th July(Mon), 2019.**
2. For M.Ed. program the minimum eligibilities are:
 - B.Ed. degree from Rajiv Gandhi University or any other UGC recognized University/ College/ Institute with at least 50% marks.
 - SC/ST candidates shall be given relaxation of 5% marks.
 - Candidates who have appeared in qualifying Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) Examination can also apply. **However, such candidates will have to submit the proof of having passed the qualifying examination latest by 22nd July(Mon), 2019.**
3. For B.Ed.Spl.Ed(LD) program the minimum eligibilities are:
 - B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. and equivalent degree at graduation level with minimum 50% marks in the qualifying degree examination.
 - SC/ST and OBC (NCL) candidates shall be given relaxation of 5% marks. The NCL candidates should produce NCL Certificate issued for the current year.
 - Candidates who are appearing in qualifying (Bachelor Degree) Examination can also apply. **However, such candidates will have to submit the proof of having passed the qualifying examination latest by 29th July(Mon), 2019.**

- ❖ **Issue of Prospectus containing Application Form from College office for B.Ed(Gen) course is from 21st June (Friday) 2019 to 15th July (Monday) 2019, for M.Ed. Course is from 21st June (Friday) 2019 to 22nd July (Monday) 2019 and for B.Ed.Spl.Ed(LD) Course is from 21st June (Friday) 2019 to 29th July (Monday) 2019 .**
- ❖ **Filled in Application form to reach the college office for B.Ed(Gen) course is latest by 15th July (Monday) 2019, for M.Ed. Course is 22nd July (Monday) 2019 and for B.Ed.Spl.Ed(LD) course is 29th July (Monday) 2019.**
- ❖ **Application and Prospectus can be had from the college office on payment of Rs. 300/- by cash or Rs. 350/- through Demand Draft in favour of “The Chairman, Hills College of Teacher Education, Naharlagun”, payable at “Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh”.**
- ❖ **A total of Rs 400/- will be charged for those applications to be sent by post.**
